

ANNEX B – MANDATORY CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT revised 09/12/2024

1. The following items must be carried throughout the Ten Tors Challenge (TTC), Jubilee Challenge (JC) and Jubilee Challenge Plus (JC+).
2. The items and quantities listed are the minimum required – more may be necessary to ensure individuals are suitably equipped to complete their Challenge even in adverse conditions. Notwithstanding compliance with this list, the organisers may Crash Out participants from a Challenge before or after the start if they consider them to be unsuitably clothed or equipped to complete it in the forecast conditions.
3. Walkers must know how to use the items. Further guidance is on the Ten Tors Website at Information – Guidance – Clothing and Equipment.
4. An asterisk (*) indicates that the item will be issued during Registration in Okehampton Camp.
